Proprietor and winemaker, Dave Bate (above), has been marketing the Tantra Limited Release and Kiss and Tell Reserve 2004 – both red blends – exclusively in the northern climes of Canada, but has negotiated miniscule distribution locally for June (see how they rated in our tasting on page 86). Only 16 barrels of each wine were produced. Expect a bottle of each to retail for approximately R125.
